Society Golf at Seckford

If you are thinking about organising a Society day then our course could not be better suited. We have a full 18 hole Golf Course, driving range/practice ground, fully licensed bar and The Terrace Restaurant.

Due to our course, we are confident in saying that all types of golfer will enjoy their day with us. For the more experienced golfer, the course provides an interesting challenge with accuracy and a good short game being paramount. Yet the novice can feel comfortable whilst playing as the course is not long and daunting. If you happen to have people within your group that are very new to golf or have never played then we suggest they enjoy a clinic on the range with our qualified PGA professional, Simon Jay.

We have 4 buggies on site that are available for hire all year round (depending on conditions). We can also hire out trolleys, shoes and half sets of clubs for those who require them. Should your group need any Longest Drive or Nearest the Pin Markers then we will be happy to provide them for you (please request in advance).

On completion of play, your group can enjoy drinks at the bar before sitting down to eat in The Terrace Restaurant, where all the food is prepared fresh using locally sourced ingredients. We are able to cater for any requirements from Coffee and Bacon Rolls on arrival to a full 3 Course Dinner at very competitive prices.

Finally, should you wish to purchase prizes for your day then we have a well-stocked shop and we would be more than happy to assist you with your selections.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO SOCIETY/GROUP ORGANISERS:

On booking, the Organiser of the Society agrees to be responsible for the behaviour and conduct of their players. We urge all Organisers to ensure their group are aware of the following Rules and Etiquette so to avoid any embarrassment on the day.

Seckford Golf Club reserve the right to refuse admission to any players if they are improperly attired, are heavily under the influence of alcohol or drugs or if they are abusive to any member of staff. In serious cases these may lead to the entire group being ejected from the Course without entitlement to a refund.

DRESS CODE:

We ask that all our visitors follow our dress code at all times for the Golf Course and Clubhouse. They are outlined as follows:

On the Course:

- No Light Denim, Tracksuit or Non-tailored Trousers
- Shorts may be worn but must be tailored
- Socks to be worn with shorts or skirts (they do not have to be long socks)
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times, unless made to be worn specifically on the outside.
- A shirt with a collar must be worn. No T-Shirts, Large logos/slogans or shirts specific to another sport i.e. Football, Rugby or Hockey.
- Golf Shoes must be worn when on the course. In extreme circumstances smart, flat trainers may be allowed, at Club's discretion.

In the Clubhouse:

- Smart Casual at all times.
- Golf Shoes may be worn throughout the Clubhouse. Please ensure that you clean shoes before entering clubhouse.
- Caps and hats are not to be worn inside.

ETIQUETTE AND RULES:

We do not require handicap certificates, but we ask players to follow all codes of conduct whilst on the course. Below is a list of do's and don'ts that we ask all organisers to make their group aware of:

Do's...

Enjoy your round of golf
Invite faster players to play through
Rake bunkers and replace flags correctly
Shout 'FORE' if you hit towards others
Replace your divots
Repair pitch marks
Drive buggies sensibly
Wear appropriate clothing & footwear
Turn off your mobile phone

Don'ts...

Use abusive language or behaviour
Consume alcohol on the golf course
Throw equipment
Litter
Shout unnecessarily
